

REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING
A HEALTH CERTIFICATE FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

You will need to take your pet to your veterinarian for a health exam and for completion of the international health certificate. **NOTE: European countries have their own individual health certificates. Please check the above website to verify what is needed.**

We will endorse your document and mail it back to you by the method you have provided.
Please allow sufficient time for us to examine your documents and to return them to you.
