As owner of the above animal, I authorize Old Derby Animal Hospital staff to anesthetize my pet today to perform a dental cleaning. I understand that some risk is present with any procedure or medication and that I am encouraged to discuss any concerns I have about those risks with the attending veterinarian before the procedure is initiated.

**To be admitted for a procedure involving anesthesia, your pet must have been fasted overnight. If you are unsure, please tell the admitting technician so anesthesia can be administered later in the day.**

To minimize the inherent risk of anesthesia and to fully assess your pet's current oral health, all patients must have a comprehensive physical examination within six months of the scheduled procedure. A pre-surgical blood evaluation of circulating blood counts and organ function will have had to been completed prior to your pet's procedure. In situations where additional unanticipated services are required, we will make every effort to contact you for authorization. If the animal is under anesthesia and you cannot be reached, the veterinarian will use his/her best judgment and complete the procedure to minimize risk to the pet.

In the event that moderate to advanced periodontal disease is detected in your pet, the attending veterinarian may recommend one or more of the following additional periodontal procedures. Additional charges will apply.

May we take intraoral x-rays if it's needed to assess the health of a tooth? YES NO

If we find periodontal pockets of bacterial infection between the teeth and gums, but feel that the tooth does not need to be extracted, may we treat the pocket with a long acting antibiotic solution? YES NO
